

Seller's Breeding Notes:

TJ Farms: Lots #41-96

Heifers exposed to Low BW Blairs.Ag Red Angus bulls to start calving later February (bulls out May 15)

They are Ivomeced and had Bovishield Gold FP5, Ultrabac 7, Anthrax, Tasvax.

Fall preg checking found them all to have caught and to calve by the end of March.

(Lot 70 will likely calve in April)

7 Heifers with White ear tags are 75% Simmental & 25% Red Angus (Lots 50, 54, 66, 67, 69, 86, 95) (F2),

all others are 50% Simmental & 50% Red Angus (F1)

BlairsWest: Lots #1-40

Lot #s 1-25 are all AI bred May 8 to our herdsire Red U2 Revival 147G who was Grand Champion Red

Angus bull at Farm Fair International and CN Supreme qualifier, and were preg tested in August as catching to the AI and due to calve mid-February.

Lot #s 26-40 are bred to the exposure of Red Blair's Next 31G for 45 days and are due March 1 – March 30

They are all by Red Angus bulls and out of Fleck Simmental cows.

They had all vaccinations and their 1st Scour Guard shot, and have been Ivomeced

Colborn Farms: Lots #102-151

Heifers exposed to Low BW Red Angus bulls to start calving March 15 – 60 day exposure

They are all Red Angus X Simmental. They have been Ivomeced and had their vaccinations.

They have been preg checked and all are expected to calve from March 15 to the end of April

Blairs.Ag: Lots #97-101

They have been vaccinated with Bovishield Gold, Ultrabac, Somubac, and Safeguard and are Ivomeced

All are due Feb.20 – AI'd to Red Angus, then exposed to a Red Angus bull.

Lots 97, 100, 101 caught to the AI, Lots 98, 99 were pasture exposed and should calve late March
