





It reduces disposition issues, allows us to sensibly manage growth and increases longevity. Our bulls have as much space as most any bullpen in the country. They are active and always moving. We could make them bigger, heavier and fatter but no one wins in that scenario.

As always, our entire offering is DNA parent verified, polled and colour tested where necessary and has genomically enhanced EPD's. This greatly increases the accuracy of EPD's using DNA. We believe in providing you with the most accurate information to help in your selection.

Our life revolves around the Gelbvieh breed! We hope you see the pride we take in our work as you evaluate the bulls. It would be our privilege to tour you through the cattle here at the farm anytime. We want you to see your bull's mother! 


